

HERE'S HOW TO REGISTER FOR YOUR BCEID AND ONLINE EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

1. Logon to <https://apply.workbc.ca>
2. From the Welcome to Online Employment Services, Select "Create an Account"

5. Create a **Basic BCEID** OR if you already have one, sign in using your **Basic BCEID** and Password. If you are not sure if you have a BCEID, click "Not Sure".

6. Follow the instructions on the screen to create a Basic BCe ID (if you don't have one) or continue with your existing BCeID log in and password. You will need to create a User ID and Password as well as provide 2 password reset security questions.

7. If you are registering for a new BCeID, you will receive an email with a link; please click on the link and complete the final stage of your registration for BCeID/OES services.
8. Once the OES registration is complete and you have created your OES account, you will need to sign in and complete the application to receive case managed services. This will include a series of questions regarding your current and past employment etc.
