

Pre-Reading

Questions:

- 2. When you give acts of kindness, how does it make you feel? Why do you think that is?
- 3. What is a hijab? Give a short lesson on the significance and origin of the hijab.

While Reading

Questions:

- 1. Activity: Faizah's teacher asks, "What kind of world do you want?"
 - Have students draw the world they want.
 - Lead a discussion where students can share their visions.
- 2. Why does Faizah feel both happy and sad seeing the other matching siblings on picture day?
- 3. How do Faizah's friends show her kindness?

- 2. What happens when we all commit to being kinder and making the world a good place?
- 3. What are some things you admire about your sibling(s), or your friends?
